Welcome to Angie Hahn's Academy of Dance for the 2022-23 Season! We are so excited to begin fall classes with all of you. Below you will find information about our calendar, fees, costumes, and more. Please give this a good read, and welcome to the AHAD family!

General Studio Information

- Our dance year runs from September through June.
- Dancers in recital classes will perform in our June recital (with costumes).
- We require all studio families to have a credit card on file.
- Our studio has a uniformity policy. Leotards and tights can be purchased at the studio.

Registration Information

- A \$45 non-refundable fee is due at the time of registration. This fee holds your child's place in the dance class.
- Upon receiving your filled-out registration/contact form, you will receive an email with instructions on how to set up your online account, pay your reg fee, enter a credit card to keep on file, & view your dancer's schedule.

Tuition & Costume Fee Information

- Tuition is due in 9 monthly payments; at the beginning of the months Sept-May (no June payment)
- Tuition rates depend on the length of the class but range from \$50-\$55 per month.
- Discounts are applied as your dancer takes more classes.
- Costume Deposits are \$50 per routine and are due November 1st
- Costume Balances will vary and will be due February 1st.

Length of Class / Amount Due Per Month

- 30-minute classes are \$50 per month
- 45-minute classes are \$52 per month
- 1 hour (or more) classes are \$55 per month

Multiple Class Discounts (per family)

- 3 classes = 5% off monthly total
- 4 = 8% off
- 5 = 12% off
- 6 = 17% off
- 7 = 23% off
- 8 = 28% off
- 9 = 33% off
- 10 = 38% off
- 11 or more = 40% off

The studio is closed on the following dates:

Feb 20	Martin Luther King Day
March 27-April 2	Spring Break
May 26-29	Memorial Day Weekend

The first day of classes is: Monday, September 12

Other Policies

- No adjustments are made in the tuition for absences.
- Any student with an outstanding tuition balance will not be permitted to perform in our recital.
- In the event that a student has to drop a class/classes before the end of the school year, the tuition reimbursement will be prorated to the end of the month that his/her last class was taken. A \$25 cancellation fee will also be deducted from the refunded tuition amount.
- No refunds are not given for canceled classes due to weather or power outages.
- The fee for a returned check is \$25
- We cannot offer a refund for costumes even if your student drops a class before the recital. Costume companies rarely allow returns.

UNIFORMITY POLICY

Personal appearance plays an essential role as part of our dance program. Class uniformity is strictly enforced. If you have a question regarding uniformity, consult with your teacher BEFORE you make your purchase.

THE BALLET CLASS	HAIR MUST BE PULLED BACK AND OFF THE FACE. Primary Levels: A bun, ponytail or braids are recommended. Elementary/Intermediate/Advanced level: Hair in a bun is required. All ballet students wear pink ballet shoes. Leotard and Tights must be purchased through the studio.
PRE-BALLET	Light blue leotard and pink tights must be purchased through the studio.
PRIMARY BALLET	Black leotard and pink tights must be purchased through the studio.
ELEMENTARY BALLET	Royal Blue leotard and pink tights must be purchased through the studio. When taking two ballet classes weekly, this leotard will be worn in both classes.
INTERMEDIATE BALLET	Teal green leotard and pink tights must be purchased through the studio. This leotard will be worn in both of their ballet classes.
ADVANCED BALLET	Any black leotard may be worn in their regular classes. Open Ballet: Any solid leotard may be worn.
JAZZ & TAP CLASSES	All JAZZ & TAP STUDENTS wear black leotards, Capezio #1816 Ultra Soft Footless Caramel Tights. Leotards must be solid black. JAZZ STUDENTS wear Caramel color split sole shoes. Capezio #CG05 (gore boot) or EJ2. Bloch #S0495 (Tan). Intermediate and Advanced dancers see Miss Angie. TAP STUDENTS – Our younger dancers wear Bloch (Tap-On) #S0302L in tan or Capezio #3800 in Carmel. Elementary/Intermediate level dancers wear lace-up tan oxford style tap shoes. Teletone taps are recommended. Please consult with your teacher to determine correct tap shoes.
CONTEMPORARY	Black leotard and footless caramel or pink tights. Hair off the face and in a ponytail.
HIP HOP	Hair should be pulled off the face. Consult teacher to determine correct shoes.
BOYS	Ballet Classes: Black tights, fitted white shirt and black ballet shoes. Jazz and Tap Classes: White shirt, shorts or fitted dance pants that do not drag on the floor. All dance shoes should be black.

***Please note: Any student having consecutive classes should wear the ballet uniform for both classes.**
